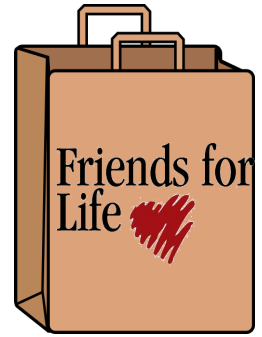

FOOD SHELF NEEDS

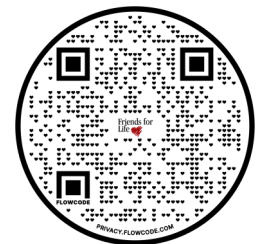
- Canned soup
